Before contact with Europeans, the Ojibwe practiced a seasonal cycle of hunting, fishing, and gathering in order to survive. Ningo Gikinonwin: Ojibwe Four Seasons celebrates this circle of life. These exceptionally-produced programs are narrated by young Ojibwe children and are told through extraordinary reenactments at Waswagoning, a recreated 17th-century Ojibwe village. Students see how time has altered some Ojibwe customs and practices while others have continued into the present. The series can serve as a springboard for lessons on First Peoples cultures, including their traditions, family structure, sense of community, and language—as well as provide opportunities to learn about time, continuity, and change as they affect culture.
